Continuing our theme of making golf accessible for all, we're proud to offer a range of membership options designed to suit every golfer. Whether you're looking for unlimited access or a flexible approach, we're confident you'll find the right fit.

Full Memberships

Our traditional full membership remains a popular choice and is available across several age categories.

All adult full memberships include:

- **Unlimited golf**
- **Free use of the short game facilities**
- **Discounted items within the pro shop**
- Access to **members only competitions and social events**

This option is ideal for golfers who enjoy regular play and want to make the most of everything the club has to offer.

Points Membership

The **Points System** offers a flexible alternative to full membership and is particularly appealing for new golfers or those who play less frequently.

- Annual bundle: **£250**
- One time joining fee: **£50**
- Points are deducted per round depending on the how many holes you play
- When your points run out, you can: Purchase another bundle, upgrade to a full membership, pay standard green fees.

This option is perfect for golfers who want to try the course before committing to full membership, or for those who are members elsewhere and simply want a change of scenery.

Annual minimum: 60 points **Non transferable:** Points cannot be transferred to another golfer.

Points Tariff: 9 holes: 4 points 18 holes: 6 points

- A reduced EG affiliation fee is paid for under 18's
- Tee restrictions for U12,U16,U18 and 18-24 are; Weekend play only permitted after 12 noon from 1st Oct - 31st March / Weekend play only permitted after 2pm 1st April - 30th Sept
- All members play on the course is subject to the restrictions of weather, maintenance and club matches. Tee times can be booked in person or by telephone up to 7 days in advance.
- Shop discount applies to 'stocked products' only and does not include any item/s ordered in specifically. Discounts are not applicable to items already subject to discounts or offers.
- Guests visits are restricted by category. Guests are charged a discounted rate which is sold through your membership account for future reference.
- Membership renewals are emailed approximately 60 days prior to the renewal date. Early payment discounts are available for some memberships.

Joining Fees

All new members are required to pay a **one off joining fee** when first joining Bramford Golf Centre. This fee is also payable if a previous membership has **lapsed** and the individual chooses to rejoin at a later date.

Members who renew annually **in line with the terms set out in their renewal email or letter** are *not* required to pay an additional joining fee.

Affiliation Fees

Each member is required to pay an **annual affiliation fee**. This fee is set by **England Golf (EG)** and the **Suffolk Golf Union Ltd (SGU)**.

Bramford Golf Centre Ltd collects these fees — which are **subject to VAT** — and passes them on **in full** to EG and SGU.

Affiliation fees may vary depending on several factors.

A member of staff will be happy to discuss these details if required.

Early Settlement Discounts

From 2026, all adult full memberships will include an **early settlement discount**. Renewal emails will be issued approximately **60 days before your renewal date**, giving members additional time to take advantage of the offer.

If your membership is renewed **before the specified early settlement deadline**, a discount will automatically be applied to your renewal fee.

Early settlement discounts do not affect future renewal dates. Your membership will continue to be renewable on the same date each year, regardless of whether you choose to pay early.

Members Guests

Members are welcome to bring guests to play at BGC. However, discounted members guest fees are limited by membership category. When joining/renewing you will be issued with a membership card that details your membership specifics and records your discounted guest visits. It is the responsibility of the member to present this card when signing a discounted guest in. Without the presence of your card discounted rates may be refused.

Temporary Membership Suspensions

If a member is unable to play golf due to a medical condition, they may request a temporary suspension of their membership. All suspension requests must be submitted in writing and supported by appropriate medical evidence.

Key terms:

- A medical suspension may be granted for a maximum period of up to **three months** in any membership year.
- Suspensions cannot be applied **retrospectively**; the suspension will begin from the date the written request is received.
- Members must notify the club as soon as they are able to resume playing.
- Suspensions are granted at the discretion of the club and may be declined if sufficient evidence is not provided.

This clause ensures fairness for members experiencing genuine medical difficulties while maintaining clarity and consistency for club administration.

Rules and Conditions of Membership

A membership will start when the application is accepted by the directors and will end 365 days later. Members must abide by the Rules of Golf, the rules of the course and observe golf etiquette at all times. The director reserve the right to change and amend any rules of the course and any rules and conditions of the memberships. Members shall be entitled to use and enjoy the facilities in accordance with their annual membership category. However the director reserves the right to close the course, clubhouse and other facilities at certain times for reasons of inclement weather, alterations, maintenance and events not open to members or any other reason that the directors shall decide. If at any time, it is considered by the director that a members' conduct is not in the best interests of the club that a membership may be cancelled by the director. In such circumstances the member shall not be entitled to any refund.

Rules of the course

- 1: All players must sign in the shop before play
- 2: All players must abide by the rules of golf and observe etiquette at all times
- 3: Slower players **MUST** let faster players through
- 4: All players must have a bag of clubs Smart dress is required. Torn and dirty clothing is not acceptable. Golf shoes or suitable flat-soled are expected. Shirts must be worn.
- 5: At busy times the professional staff reserve the right to join up one and two ball matches.
